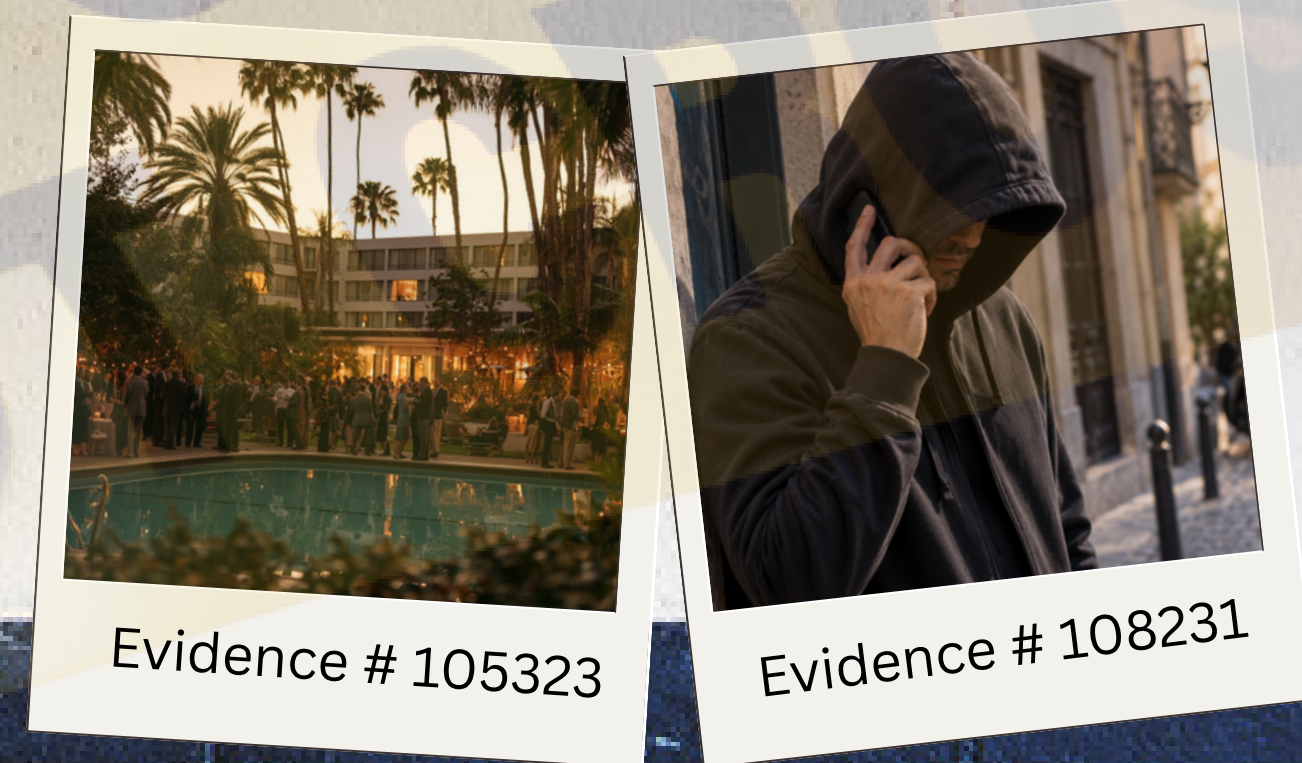
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THE STORY

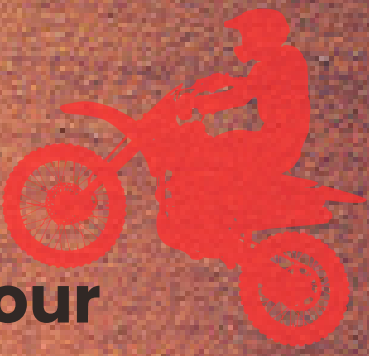


LOGLINE: Set against the backdrop of Madrid's gay neighborhood of Osera, a seemingly perfect group of longtime friends is targeted by a mysterious enemy, forcing them to uncover old secrets, confront buried tensions, and try to survive in the process.

OSERA is an ensemble dramedy and mystery-thriller centered on a tight-knit group of mainly LGBTQ+ friends in Madrid whose chosen family is tested when they become the targets of a mysterious campaign of threats and violence. The pilot begins with Rodrigo and Tommy's chaotic Mallorca wedding, introducing a colorful group bound by decades of friendship, complicated romances, secrets and old wounds. Their celebration is shattered when Elena's beloved Dolores Café is destroyed in a suspected arson attack. Soon, anonymous messages, a deliberate attack on Pablo and a sinister countdown reveal that someone is targeting them one by one. As the friends attempt to uncover who is behind the threats, suspicion grows within the group—particularly around the increasingly secretive Froi. OSERA blends humor, sex, romance and queer friendship with an unfolding mystery in which the friends' shared past may hold the key to surviving their future.



CREATOR'S STATEMENTS



What is Osera and what are Bears?

"Osera" in Spanish means the Bear's den or lair and it's also the name of our fictional gayborhood. Bears are traditionally more stocky, beefier members of the gay male community.

Why this, why now?

Until now, LGBTQ+ characters haven't really been seen as the heroes of stories, but instead they've been relegated to supporting characters such as the quirky sidekick. I created this series to shine a light on a large portion of the community that has remained unseen on Tv and show that, they too can be the main characters to a story that affects all of us.

Why would I want to keep watching?

Sex, crime, action, friendship, betrayal and more. This series has it all. We follow this group of unlikely heroes that are unwillingly propelled into action to save their community, friends and themselves from destruction, but in the meantime, they can also have a little bit of fun.

Who is the audience?

The story and conflicts are universal. Man vs.man and Man vs. machine, but the heroes and players are mainly gay men. I expect for members of the queer community, women and any person that loves a good whodunnit and thriller would gravitate towards the series. The characters represent a little piece of all of us, but they just happen to be gay.

ENGINE & SEASON



S1, Ep1	• Seven friends gather in Mallorca to celebrate Rodrigo and Tommy's wedding. • Froi arrives late, acts suspicious has blood on his eyebrow. • Elena gets a call that her restaurant, Dolores Café has burnt down. • Rodrigo and Tommy receive an ominous threat letter slipped under their front door.	• Pablo is attacked by two masked bikers. • A spoof text was sent by Javi to the friends to meet at Osiris, along with Detective Reyes. • Froi receives personal text. He knows more than we think.
S1, Ep2-4	• Javi's electric car won't stop. Brakes have failed. He's injured but ok. Another close call. • The group gets another text saying that there's only 3 days left. • Pablo meets with Detective Reyes. This is where we find out that Pablo is on the intelligence and A.I. committees and that he's privy to information. • Froi meets up with a mysterious mobster type individual, named Jules. He owes them money. • Detective Reyes starts to come on stronger to Elena.	• Someone sends private nudes to all of Liam's university rugby players. He's embarrassed and could get fired. It's yet another attack. • Rodrigo and Froi talk about their past together. Froi confesses he still has feelings for Rodrigo. • Tommy receives an anonymous video of Rodrigo and Froi closely engaged in conversation. Froi tries to kiss Rodrigo but the video cuts off. • Tommy, angered tries to leave the country but Rodrigo finds out and follows him to the airport to beg him to stay.
S1, Ep5-6	• We know now that Froi is land rich but cash poor. The mobsters want to use his land for something. • Detective Reyes is seen talking with Jules. Is he in on this? • Jules talks to his handlers on the phone. Suggests they put more pressure on him from their end. • Liam and Pablo finally kiss.	• Javi takes xanax to handle his nerves but ends up getting addicted. Somehow the computer at the pharmacy has been doubling his dosage. • It's the last day of the threat. The group is nervous on what will happen next. • Rodrigo plans on getting him and Tommy out of Osera. He creates a bug out plan and starts stockpiling self defense items and survival tools.
S1, Ep7-8	• Pablo is kidnapped by 3 masked men on his way to work. They are part of the CNI intelligence team. They let him know that they're being targeted. • Detective Reyes has been tapped by CNI to play a double agent and gather intel on the group and why they are so important.	• Elena finds out Reyes hasn't been all too transparent. • Elena tells the group that Froi was an early investor in Dolores Café. • Froi confesses about his involvement in Dolores Café's fire. He didn't know they were going to burn it down entirely. He needed the insurance money. • The team forgives Froi and decide to fight the nefarious group that's after them.
